Description

Provide First Aid (formerly Apply First Aid or Senior First Aid) is a comprehensive first aid course suitable for everyday emergency situations. This qualification meets the requirement, set out in the Code of Practice, for a Senior First Aider.

Gain skills in managing an unconscious, breathing patient; CPR (Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation); choking; wounds and bleeding; burns; medical emergencies including chest pain, asthma, anaphylaxis; shock; infection control, and trauma including fractures, head, neck and spinal injuries.

- **Up to 4 hours online to complete e-Learning modules.**
- **1 Full Day In class to complete practical component and assessments.**
