- **Increase cultural knowledge and understanding.**
- **Improve attitudes, behaviours and actions towards Aboriginal people.**
- **Positively impact the health and wellbeing of Aboriginal people through improving the skills of health professionals.**
- **Engage staff with authentic stories of Aboriginal peoples' experience of healthcare providing insight to enhance the development of deep and lasting empathy for Aboriginal people.**
- **Recognise how healthcare outcomes for Aboriginal people can be improved through greater awareness of Aboriginal culture.**
- **Challenge pre-conceived perceptions or beliefs about working with and providing health services to Aboriginal people and in particular dismantle the stereo-typing of Aboriginal people.**
- **Understand how Aboriginal people may view healthcare and the barriers that can prevent individuals or groups from accessing services.**

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
