- Pre-course reading - CRANAplus Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Maternity Emergency Care Course Manual
- Attendance at a three-day face-to-face workshop consisting of lectures, skill stations and practical based scenarios
- An on-course multi-choice quiz.
- An individual scenario based clinical skills assessment

On successful completion participants will be awarded:

- A CRANAplus Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Maternity Emergency Care Certificate
