- Understand and identify factors that contribute to experiences of trauma.
- Identify and understand the pathophysiology and clinical aspects of the body's response to trauma.
- Respond to and provide services that are trauma informed.

## LOCATION

This course is mainly delivered online, with a one week face-to-face residential which will be delivered at the Shoalhaven Campus, located in Nowra, New South Wales. Our Shoalhaven Campus encompasses teaching spaces, a library as well as a cafe and student facilities. Students attending the Shoalhaven Campus have access to the full range of services offered by the University of Wollongong and learning is supported by easy access to computers and information technology.

## COMMONWEALTH SUPPORTED PLACES (CSP)

UOW has government subsidised places available for domestic students studying this course in 2019, subject to quota availability. A CSP is where the Australian Government contributes up to three quarters of your total tuition fee. To be eligible for a CSP you must be an Australian or New Zealand citizen or the holder of a permanent visa, and meet the criteria outlined at [studyassist.gov.au](http://studyassist.gov.au)

If you're an eligible Commonwealth supported student you can access HECS-HELP to defer part or all of your tuition fees.
