



## Terms and Conditions - 2018 Cancer Awareness Skill Set (Short Course)

### ELIGIBILITY

- It is a requirement that the scholarship holder must be of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent
- The applicant must be a citizen of New South Wales
- All scholarship holders will be required to produce a up to date vaccination record, and may be required to have vaccinations if they are not complete
- You must be currently employed as an Aboriginal Health Worker

### TENURE

- The scholarship is available for a maximum period of 3 months, including work placement hours, if applicable (March 2019)
- It is self-paced learning with the flexibility to complete sooner if practicable
- Scholarship holders will be provided with a mentor in the Cancer sector to assist them in completing their studies
- Scholarship holders will also receive fortnightly communication from the Poche Centre to assist them to complete their studies
- Students will be provided with a laptop computer to assist them to complete their studies
- The laptop will remain the property of the scholarship holder at the completion of the program.

### EMPLOYMENT

- If the Scholarship holder is working in a related field, it is possible that the work placement can be completed at their place of work.

### TRAVEL AND MEALS

- Scholarship holders must be prepared to travel to a nominated destination once over the 3months to complete face-to-face study sessions. It is recommended you seek approval from your workplace prior to putting in an application
- Travel arrangements will be paid for and organised by the Poche Centre for Indigenous Health however, replacement of missed flights need to be covered by the scholarship holder
- Poche Staff will require you to approve travel before any travel is booked for the scholarship holder
- Scholarship holder wishes to change details of flight after they have been approved need be covered by the scholarship holder
- Scholarship holders are required to give the Poche Centre 48 hours' notice if they are not able to make it to block- failure to do so may put your scholarship in jeopardy
- Vouchers will be given to all students to allow for self-catering when staying on block and meals will be covered where necessary
- A group scholarship dinner will be held during the week student must notify unable to attend.

### CHANGES OF ENROLMENT

- Scholarship holders must notify the Poche Centre for Indigenous Health promptly of any changes to their enrolment including but not limited to: attendance pattern, suspension, leave of absence, withdrawal.

### TERMINATION

- The scholarship will be terminated on resignation or withdrawal of the student from the study program
- All learning materials such as the Laptops are to be returned to the Poche Centre for Indigenous Health.
