Join an Aboriginal-led team aiming to improve outcomes for First Nations children, families, and communities experiencing childhood cancer. Projects can be designed according to your degree and research interests. The list below highlights just some of the research projects our team has available for honours, masters, PhD and MD students:

- Qualitative research: Interviews and yarning circles aimed at understanding community priorities for childhood cancer research
- Policy: Developing national guidelines for biobanking and cancer research using samples from Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples
- Genomics: Characterising the molecular genetics and pharmacogenomics of paediatric cancer in First Nations children
- Laboratory research: Testing the effects of bush medicines on cancer and supportive care
- Clinical research: Understanding the side effects experienced by Aboriginal children undergoing cancer treatment in WA (for MD students)
