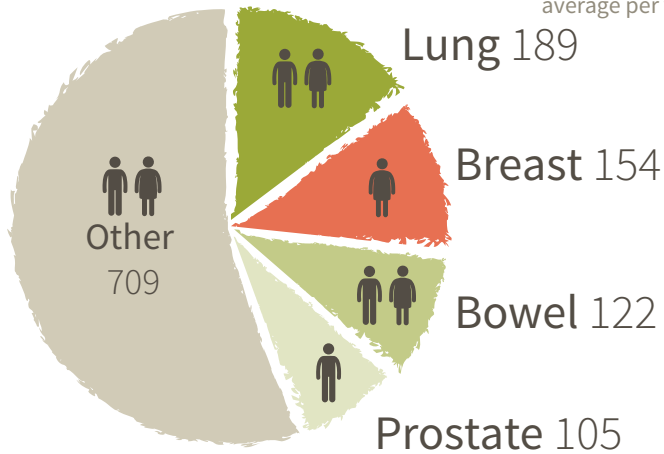




Cancer among Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people

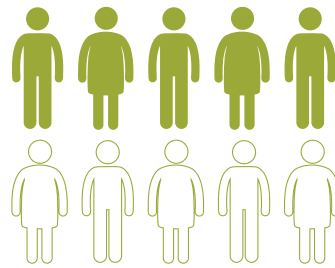
1,279 New cases diagnosed average per year

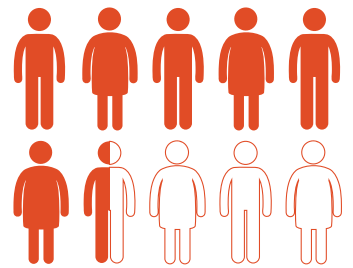
Chance of surviving at least 5 years
