Palliative Care South Australia (PCSA) is seeking Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander Consultants / Officers to work on **A Tailored Education and Training Suite to Support Palliative Care Service Delivery for Aboriginal and / or Torres Strait Islander Peoples Project** over the next three years to consult with Australian General Practice Accreditation Limited (AGPAL), the project lead, other stakeholders and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities in the development and trialing of palliative care education and training resources.

The Project partners are actively seeking Aboriginal and / or Torres Strait Islander consultants / staff to support this exciting Project. Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples are strongly encouraged to apply.

The education and training resources developed in this Project will be targeted at: -

- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health Workers and Practitioners
- Students seeking to become Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health Workers and Practitioners
- Any other health professionals who support Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander patients and their families, carers and wider communities.

The Aboriginal Liaison Consultant(s) / Officer(s) will carry out the following key national roles: -

- Support establishment of the Advisory and Working Groups and Consortium Arrangement
- Identify and liaise with key stakeholders and participants
- Promotion of all face to face events and online training
- Coordination of the best sites and venues in which to hold all face to face events
- Supporting the logistics for the delivery of all face to face events and online training
- Delivery of high quality training through face to face and online modes
- Assisting with the feedback and evaluation of all educational resources and training events
- Providing feedback and input into the design, content development and presentation of all educational and training resources (including feedback on the cultural appropriateness of the content and training)
- Advice re cultural safety, protocols and relevance throughout all aspects of the Project
