ABOUT THE ROLE

- Responsible for planning, coordination and control of the day to day operations of the Mens Group and for ensuring the safety, health and wellbeing of employees, members and clients.
- Responsible for planning and the coordination of cultural activities for the mens group and clients of Kurranulla
- Manage programs in accordance with government funding requirements
- Support individuals to live a fulfilling and meaningful life in their own community
- Rewarding role in an Aboriginal Community Controlled Organisation
- Access to ongoing support and development/training opportunities

The Mens Group currently runs two days per week, which is a important space for Aboriginal men to come together in the spirit of friendship and share cultural knowledge. We provide a dedicated space where Aboriginal men can meet to talk about issues impacting them.

The National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) is a new service that will provide support, care and access to services and technology for Australians with disabilities as well as their families and carers.

As a Support Worker, you will deliver a variety of services to participants to support them to live a fulfilling and meaningful life in the community. Your working day may include (but not limited to), assistance and or support with daily life, domestic activities, such as lawn mowing, social and community participation and varying skill development activities.

- Cultural awareness and understanding of disabilities upon individuals, families and carers.
- Flexibility, teamwork skills, and creative problem solving
- A current valid Driver's License and a willingness to travel in response to local needs
- Current & approved NSW Working with Children's check; Police Check and First Aid Certificate or willingness to undertake
