Support Coordination is a capacity building support intended to assist the participant to build the skills they need to understand, implement and use their plan.

A Support Coordinator is responsible for working with the participant to connect with informal, community and funded supports, and increase their capacity to maintain relationships, manage service delivery tasks, live more independently and be included in their community.
