

## Expression of Interest Overview

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The Australian and New Zealand Dialysis and Transplant Registry (ANZDATA) is seeking members of the First Nations clinical and research community to join the ANZDATA Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander working group through an Expression of Interest process. The working group is looking specifically for people with expertise in First Nations community-controlled health services, First Nations research, or with a lived experience of kidney disease as a First Nations person. The aim of the working group is to maximise the output of quality and ethical ANZDATA-based First Nations research to maximise the benefit to the First Nations community, and to continually review the scientific basis of data collection and data sovereignty.

The Working Group will have a role in providing advice to the ANZDATA Executive and operations around

- > Assessment and handling of data requests that focus on First Nations Australians living with kidney failure.
- > Annual review of data items captured by the ANZDATA survey relevant to First Nations Australians
- > Promotion and utilisation of ANZDATA data:
  - > Generation of research ideas/data analysis/publication and presentations
  - > Fielding queries/applications/suggestions for research from ANZDATA contributors outside the working group and, where deemed appropriate, facilitating such research whether that be carried out by the persons making the request, by the working group, or by a combination of the two.
- > Assistance with relevant chapter(s) for the Annual Report

This is an unpaid position. The required commitment is 4 virtual meetings per year and additional out of session communication, as necessary, via email. Support and education to working group members with a view to increasing research capacity can be provided.

First Nations people are encouraged to apply.

### What is ANZDATA?

The Australia and New Zealand Dialysis and Transplant Registry (ANZDATA) is a clinical quality registry that collects and produces a wide range of statistics relating to the outcomes of treatment of those with end-stage kidney failure. ANZDATA has been in operation since 1977 and all dialysis and transplant services, in Australia and New Zealand, contribute data to The Registry.

ANZDATA's fundamental purpose is to report on the incidence, prevalence and outcomes of dialysis and transplant treatment for patients with end stage kidney disease across Australia and New Zealand.

The ANZDATA Registry operates under the South Australian Health and Medical Research Institute (SAHMRI) – ABN 54 141 228 346.
