

Introduction to Na Joomelah

Na Joomelah is a Tackling Indigenous Smoking (TIS) program operated by the La Perouse Local Aboriginal Land Council, servicing the greater Sydney and Illawarra regions.

Our team has the capacity to facilitate smoke and vape - free community education and engagement, support smoke-free events and assist organisations to implement smoke-free policies.

Na Joomelah (Na Joom-eh-lah) translates to 'no smoking'.

Our program artwork highlights the Burri Burri (whale), the overarching ancestral being of the Dharawal people that links our creation stories from Sydney Harbour to the Illawarra. The organic pink line resembles the connection between our program and communities. The yellow arched symbol at the top of the image reflects sharing knowledge in an education circle. The three yellow symbols at the bottom are symbolic of our target audiences; pregnant women, youth and the general community.
