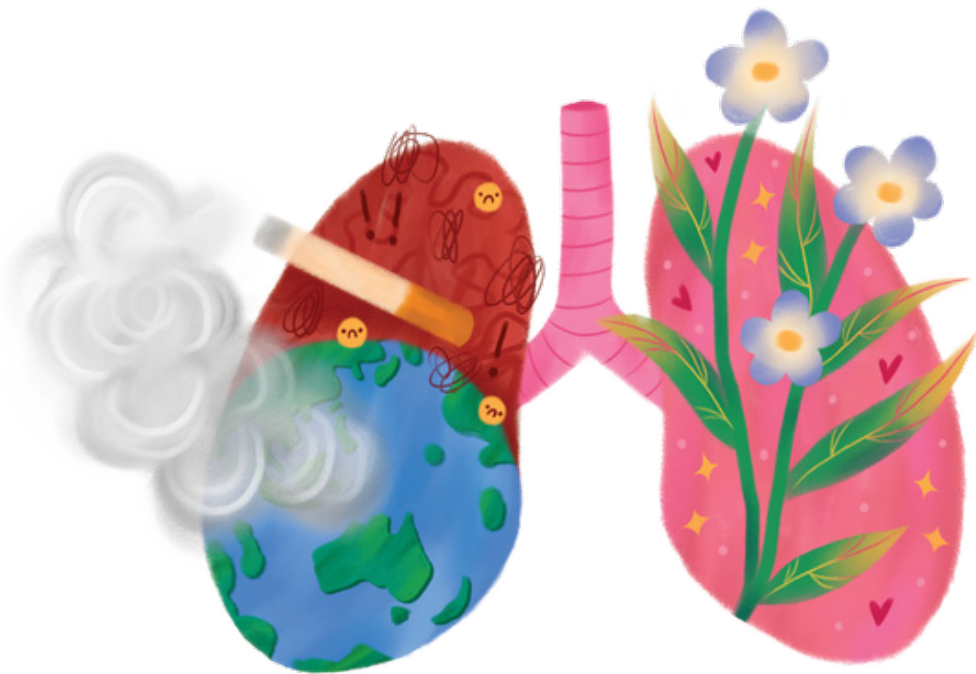
Who Does it Affect?

Why Early Screening Matters

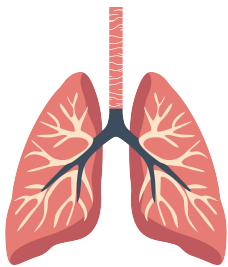
Low-dose CT scans help detect cancers early, leading to **better treatment options** and **better health outcomes**.



Who is Eligible?



Aged 50-70 years old



With no lung cancer symptoms (e.g. persistent cough, shortness of breath)



Currently smoke or have quit in the past 10 years



Have a history of smoking for at least 30 'pack-years'
