Our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Wellbeing Officers support individuals and their families with advocacy, connection and referrals to provide holistic support for individuals.

What is Naree Wandima?

Naree Wandima is Inala Wangarra's Social and Emotional Wellbeing Service supporting Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people's social and emotional wellbeing.

This service aims to empower Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, aged 14+, living within Inala and surrounding suburbs to address the impacts of alcohol and drug use.



Naree Wandima Wellbeing Officers can provide connection, advocacy, support, and referrals to other services including:

- Medical and Community Health Services*
- Drug and Alcohol Counselling*
- Rehabilitation Centres*
- Detoxification Centres*
- Community Activities and Programs*
- Services Australia-Centrelink, Medicare*
- Housing and Accommodation*
- Employment, Training and Education*
