Through strong partnerships, Jeff offers expert insights on rehabilitation, based on his experiences and his ability to engage Aboriginal communities with governments in a culturally appropriate way, leading to tangible positive outcomes in schools and communities. He credits his success to sharing his story and real-life experience.
