The Psychology Board of Australia is undertaking a preliminary survey as part of the discovery phase of the Higher Degree Redesign Project.

The purpose of the project is to provide recommendations to the Department of Health, Disability and Ageing for a proposed redesign of the psychology higher education pathway and to work toward creating a single, shorter, more practical course of study.

The purpose of this survey is to understand the current training context, opportunities for change and to obtain feedback from stakeholders, including ideas about redesign options. Stakeholder engagement is integral to the project and will inform evidence-based recommendations.
